Meeting convened at 7:05PM.

1. Cowie moved to give V. Schmalzer voting rights. E. Schmalzer seconded and the motion passed.
2. Cowie moved the October minutes. E. Schmalzer seconded the motion. The September minutes were approved.
3. Wofchuck presented an open space update including an update from Dave Viale from the Southeast Land Trust of New Hampshire (SELTNH).
4. Wofchuck and E. Schmalzer attended the Annual Meeting of the NH Association of Conservation Commissions. They attended a variety of sessions including: Wetlands 101 – Wetland Regulations and Permitting; Small Scale Habitats; Energy at the Local Level; Workforce Housing; Nitty Gritty of Conservation Financing; and Managing Town Forests for Conservation and Profit.
5. Easement Monitoring – Bunker, V. Schmalzer, Wofchuck and Kaufman have completed many of the required easement walks. Some of the reports still need to be completed. There are approximately 3 easements which are required to be completed in 2009.
6. Outreach and Events. Wofchuck and E. Schmalzer attended the Bugs in the Exeter River workshop presented by Sally Soule.
7. Wofchuck announced that Jones plans to resign from the commission. This will create an opening for a member.
