Meeting convened at 7:04PM.

1. Gilbert moved to give V. Schmalzer voting rights. Cowie seconded and the motion passed.
2. Gilbert moved the November minutes. Cowie seconded the motion. The November minutes were approved.
3. Open Space Update. Several new property owners have been contacted by Dave Viale from the Southeast Land Trust of New Hampshire (SELTNH) and are moving through the process.
4. Easement Monitoring – The easement monitoring needs to be finished up and the reports prepared.
5. The SELTNH notified the commission that they will be performing some of the annual easement monitoring based on a review of current aerial photography.
6. There will be two ordinances on the ballot this year that pertain to commission. 1) The storm water regulation passed with the planning board and will be on the ballot. 2) The workforces housing ordinance will be on the ballot.
7. There is an opening for a commission member.
8. NH DES notified the commission that they received a complete Notification of Forest Management or Timber Harvest Activities having Minor Wetlands Impact for Map/Lot 224/1.
9. Southeast Watershed Alliance. Selectmen authorized Brentwood to join. Wofchuck will be the rep unless someone else is interested. First meeting will be December 14.
