

BRENTWOOD BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 22, 2011 MEETING

The Board met and reviewed payroll, accounts payable, and signed the register. The Selectmen reviewed and signed the recreation register.

Jonathan Ellis was in to present the weekly Treasurer's report.

The Selectmen reviewed the minutes of the 2/15/11 meeting. Bryan moved the minutes as written. Byrne seconded the motion; all voted in favor. The Board reviewed the minutes of the nonpublic meeting held 2/15/11. Artimovich made a motion, seconded by Menter, to approve the minutes as written. All voted in favor.

The Board reviewed the notes:

- The Selectmen spoke with Police Chief Wayne Robinson about a request to have a relay race pass through Brentwood on June 12, 2011. Julie will forward the information to him.
- The Selectmen would like a memo sent to Fire Chief Lemoine regarding limiting the number of hours Mike Kilrain is working to 34.5/week due to NH Retirement requirements. In addition they requested a memo be sent asking Lemoine to provide the Selectmen's office with a master key and swipe card for the new station.
- Governor Lynch's proposed budget cuts include eliminating the state's contribution towards NH Retirement and moving that cost to municipalities. The affect on the Town budget would be an increase of approximately \$11,000 for police and \$4,340 for fire. In addition, it would add \$4.88 per \$100 of compensation for teachers. Based on the proposed Swasey School teacher salaries for 2011/2012, this would result in approximately \$71,000 additional in retirement expenses for the school.
- The Board approved of the Seniors holding a bake sale at the 3/8/11 election.

The Selectmen signed the following documents:

- Byrne made a motion, seconded by Menter, to sign a contract with Rockingham Planning Commission for 2011 for the Circuit Rider Planner. All voted in favor.
- Artimovich made a motion to approve an abatement for Omnipoint due to a duplicate billing of property taxes. Byrne seconded the motion; all voted in favor.
- A motion was made by Artimovich and seconded by Bryan to sign Land Use Change Tax assessments and tax collector warrants for 3 lots on South Road. All voted in favor.
- Artimovich made a motion, seconded by Byrne, to sign Land Use Change Tax assessments and tax collector warrants for 4 lots in Idyllwood. All voted in favor.
