- **THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR ALL ENTRIES IS September 1, 2017.** • All pre-registered units will receive written confirmation via e-mail acknowledging your application receipt. You MUST provide an e-mail address for confirmation of receipt of your parade entry and parade details as we get closer to the September 17, 2017 date.

The Brentwood 275th Parade will go rain or shine...there will be NOT be a rain date. If severe or dangerous weather is present on the date of the parade, the parade may be canceled.

Parade Day Information

The Brentwood 275th Parade will begin at 1:00 pm on Sunday September 17, 2017. Time and location of parade line up will be emailed to the contact prior to September 17. In the contact email, we will let you know where parade participants can be dropped off and picked up. We will also let you know the parade route and where parking will be available.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Candy or other promotional items must be distributed by WALKERS ONLY – as close to the street curb as possible to prevent young children from coming close to the moving vehicles.
- All motor vehicles must be in safe operational condition and must be operated in a safe manner at all times.

No Burn-Outs, Wheelies, or other unsafe driving acts are permitted. Failure to follow this rule will result in removal from the parade and appropriate action by law enforcement.

These rules are necessary for the safety of spectators, especially the small children along the parade route. Your cooperation is required and appreciated.
