The Board met and reviewed payroll, accounts payable and signed the register. The Selectmen reviewed and signed the recreation register.

Jonathan Ellis was in to present the weekly Treasurer's report. Please see last page to view report.

Overtime for this pay period is 4 hours in fire, 0.5 hour and 1 hour in highway.

Bryan made a motion, 2nd by Christiansen to approve the nonpublic minutes of 04/16/2013. All were in favor.

Bryan made a motion, 2nd by Christiansen to approve the public minutes of 04/23/2013. All were in favor.

Building Inspector Gil Tuck had the following building permits to be signed:

The septic systems at the town office and community center will be pumped on the 8th. Clement said the cost will be \$500 for both systems.

Artimovich and Christiansen will attend the Exeter Selectmen's meeting on 5/1/13 at 6:30pm regarding Pine Road.

There will be a joint meeting with the Epping Selectmen on 5/6/13 at 7pm at the Epping Town Hall to discuss the national June race at NED.

Michaud sent a memo to the board recommending re-granting the educational exemption on 95% of the property value located at 34 Commercial Drive. Bryan made a motion, 2nd by Menter to approve the exemption per Michaud's recommendation. All were in favor.

Christiansen made a motion, 2nd by Bryan made a motion to approve an abatement for 30 Spruce Ridge Drive per Michaud's recommendation. All were in favor.

Bryan made a motion, 2nd by Christiansen made a motion to approve an abatement for 19 Lebreaux Street per Michaud's recommendation. All were in favor.

Robinson said the fire station parking lot is marked and ready to be paved next week. Funds were encumbered from the 2012 budget to cover the cost.

Robinson said the new cruiser is on back order and will not be available until late July or August. They will be getting a 2014 model instead of 2013 at no additional cost.

They have started paving on Stevens Drive; there is concern of heavy commercial vehicles damaging the roadway. Artimovich suggested documenting the vehicles with pictures and the board will discuss issuing a letter next week if there is a zoning violation.

Clement asked Robinson when he will be able to begin the shoulder work as she has been getting a lot of calls. Robinson said they should be able to start in about 2 weeks when the paving is complete. Bryan suggested having the part timers fill in the shoulders and then they can compact and grade it once the paving is done.

The board welcomed Larry Middlemiss to Town as the new Health Officer.

Motion to adjourn at 6:25 pm made by Christiansen, 2nd by Menter; all were in favor.
