

# Fish Ladder Tour

on Water Street in downtown Exeter**

Join staff from NH Fish and Game, and members of the Exeter Conservation Commission and the Exeter-Squamscott River Local Advisory Committee for a viewing of the fish ladder located next to the Great Dam in downtown Exeter. NH Fish and Game staff will explain the purpose of the ladder and describe the fish that use the ladder during the annual spring migration from salt water in the Squamscott River to fresh water in the Exeter River. Migratory fish such as smelt, alewife, blueback herring, American shad, American eel and sea lamprey use the fish ladder to migrate upstream of the dam.
