Meeting of February 10, 2016

Cowie moved the January 13, 2016 minutes, Schmalzer seconded. Wofchuck amended the minutes to say the "The Chair is interested in hiring Moosewood for next year for the balance of the conservation commissions budget for help with grants, trail plans, etc." The minutes were approved as amended. Wofchuck received notice from NH DES that there was a heating oil spill on Middle Road and that additional actions are required. The NH DES file number is 201508033.

1. The designs for the DPW and that will be implemented in the summer.
2. The school project is slated for the spring.
