Minutes February 11, 2019

Convened at 6:00 pm

Mantegari called the meeting to order.

Wayne Robinson and John Bell, Bell and Flynn, presented a plan for road repair for Rowell Road East. Robinson said all of the trees are marked and he has a quote to have them removed. Rowell Road East is a 2 rod road, all of the trees that have been marked are in the town's right of way. They have already had the public hearing with the planning board to remove the trees.

Bell said the construction will be in 2 phases occurring concurrently. The existing pavement will be ground, adding gravel to strengthen the base, and re-pave. This will cost approximately \$120K. The unpaved portion will include tree clearing, drainage improvements, installing granite curbing to stabilize the banks and control water runoff. They will also add gravel to strengthen the base and will tie in with the existing driveways. This will cost approximately \$130K.

The culverts will be 12"-18" in diameter. The tree work is anticipated to be completed by spring. The construction and road repairs will be over about a 2 week period after school is out of session. Bell said they are looking for minimal impact on the residents.

A finish grade pavement will be laid and within the next 2-5 years another coat. Bell said the road will be crowned and they will accommodate emergency vehicles. Bell also said they will try and avoid paving on a trash day.

All of the residents that live on the road that were present are in support of this project. The vote will occur at town meeting. This project will be included in the annual appropriation for road repairs.

Mantegari made a motion, 2nd by Faria to adjourn the meeting at 6:30 pm. All were in favor.
