

BRENTWOOD CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Meeting of September 12, 2018

Meeting convened at 7 PM

Donald notified the members that Cowie is now an alternate member and that Shipley has joined the Commission as a regular member. Mark Glowacky is no longer an alternate.

Thompson/Shipley moved/seconded to give Cowie and Glowacky voting rights. Motion passed.

Shipley/Cowie moved/seconded approving the July 11, 2018 minutes. The motion passed.

A representative from VHB on behalf of Eversource presented on 2 wetland permits. They requested the town waive its right to comment on a permit that had already been approved, thus allowing them to forgo a 20-day waiting period. This was approved. Donald will send an email to Eben Lewis at NH DES.

The second wetland impact was on 8,509 square feet where they will be replacing utility poles. Depending on the exact dates of the work, they will do daily sweeps for turtles and snakes. They have worked with NH DES to get permission to access the area with their vehicles. They are going to the Planning Board next week for a conditional use permit. The work will take 7 - 10 days.

Glowacky will visit Shipley's property to work on putting together a hike when he gets back from vacation.

Wofchuck submitted a written update on the South Road project.

The Commission approved expending \$200 to reimburse the Board of Selectmen/general fund for funds spent on the wetlands permit application for the trail bridge.

The Commission is not moving forward with the recycling grant.

The Truslow invoice has been paid. Donald will get the reports from the Planning Board and forward to the Commission.

Donald and Jeremy Lougee from SELT will be presenting at an upcoming BoS meeting regarding the Martin property.

Before adjourning, Glowacky asked for clarification on the role of the Selectmen's representative and whether she is part of the quorum and if she can vote. Donald will ask Karen Clement.
